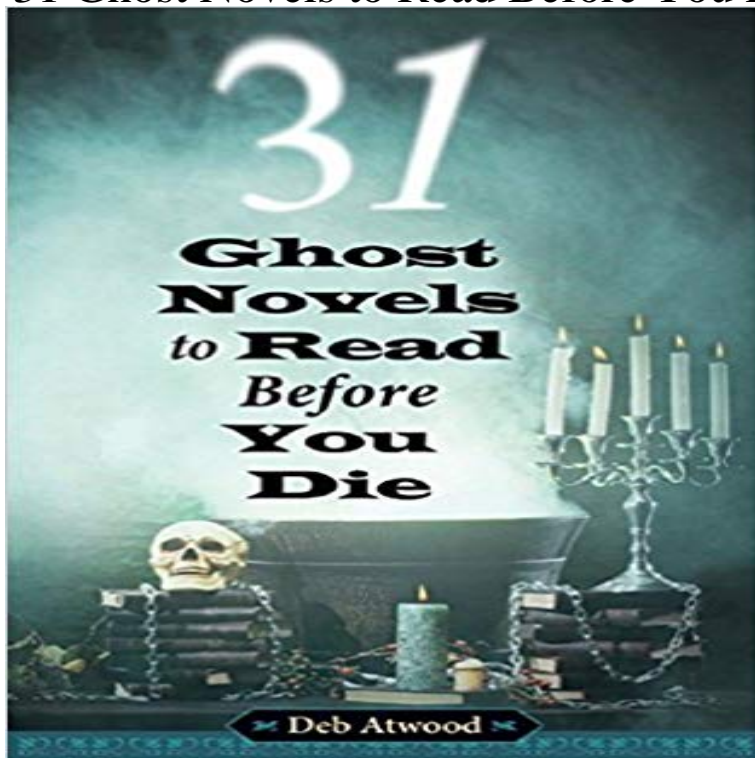


31 Ghost Novels to Read Before You Die
