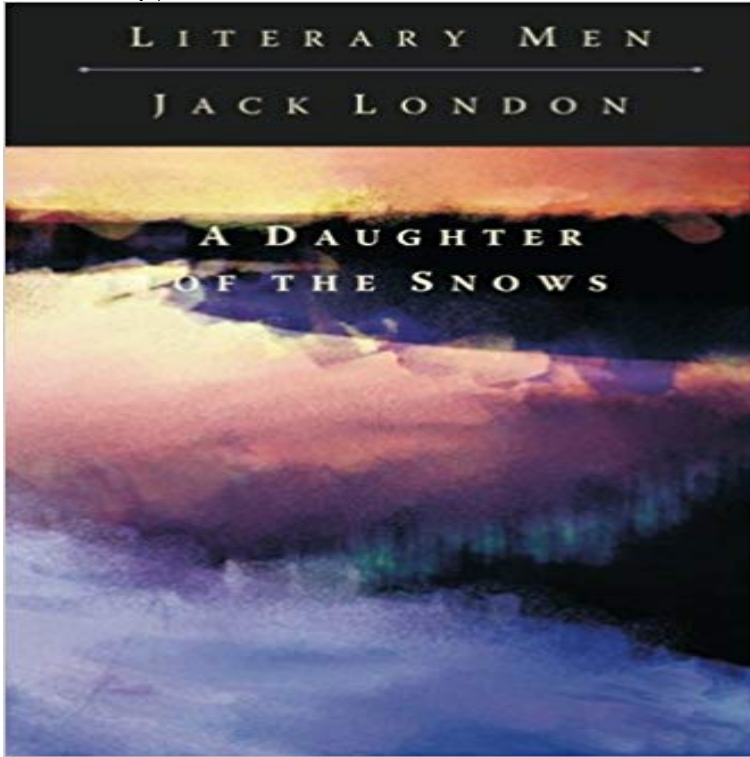


# A Daughter of the Snows
