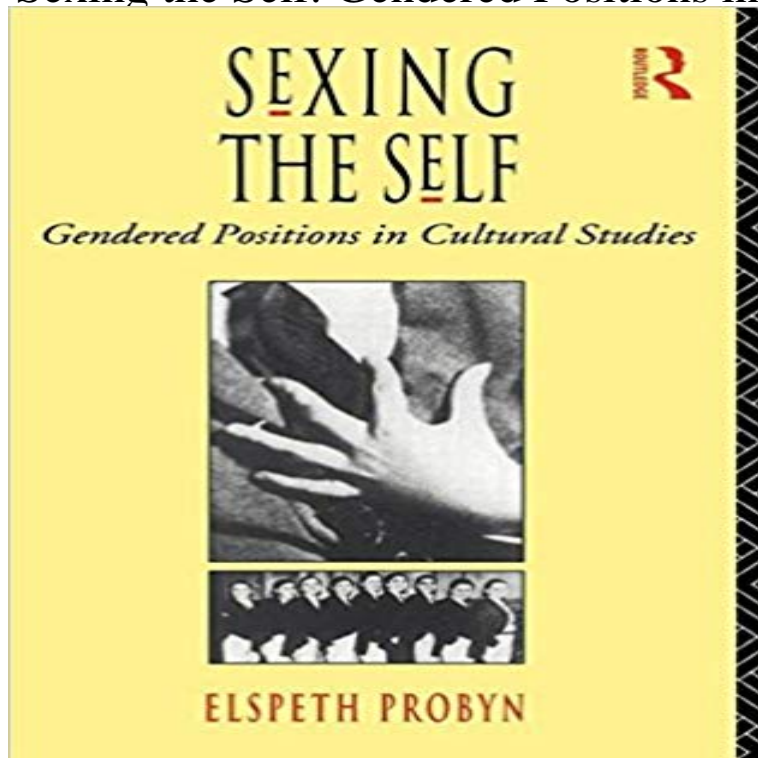


Sexing the Self: Gendered Positions in Cultural Studies
