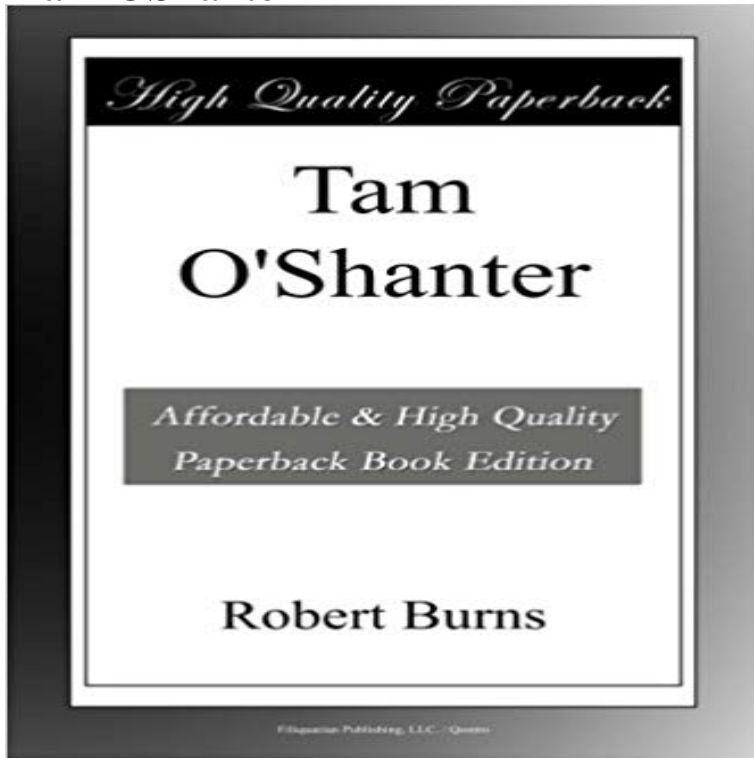


Tam OShanter
