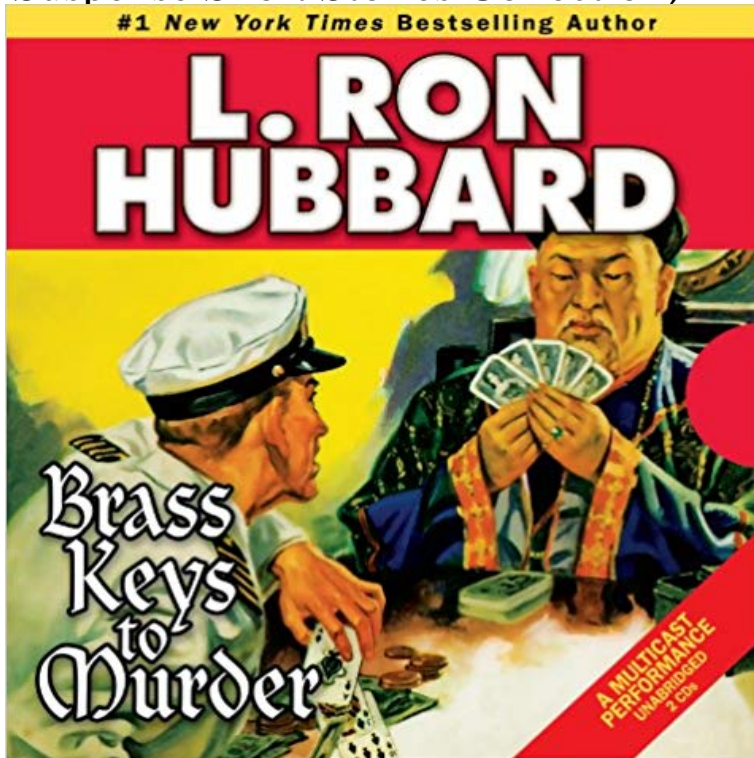


Brass Keys to Murder (Stories from the Golden Age) (Mystery & Suspense Short Stories Collection)
