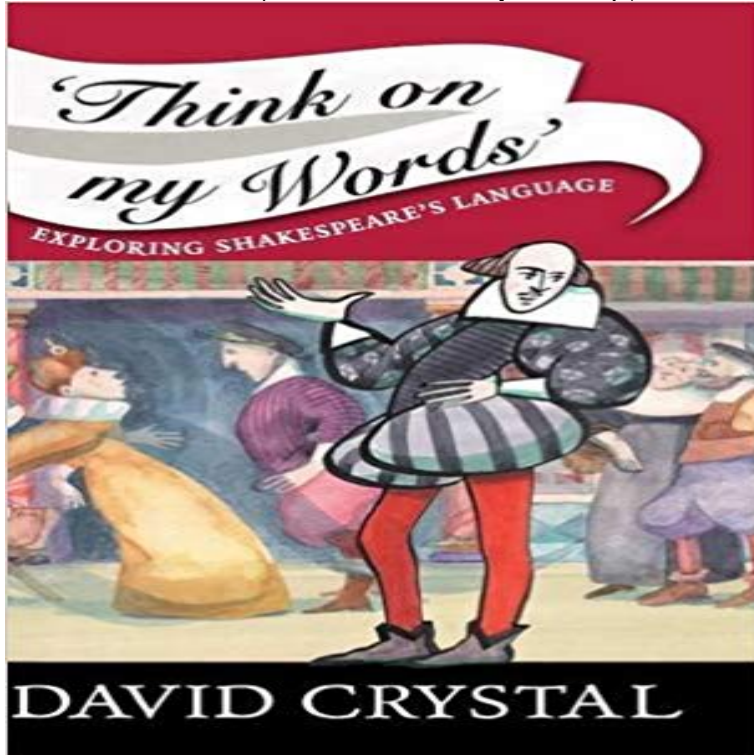


Think On My Words: Exploring Shakespeares Language
